Dear Sir / Madam,

As I am now 81 years old, I want to report a close encounter a friend and I had many years ago with a U.F.O.

I had been teaching in U.A. for 9 years, but was on leave at the time intending to travel. A teacher at Donnybrook Junior High School was badly injured in an accident so I was filling in for him before leaving. On the night we saw the U.F.O. I took my friend Annette Larosa and her sister to a dance in Capel. We went via the "Upper Capel Rd." from Donnybrook - a quiet little used road. Annette's sister stayed on at the dance after supper but Annette and I left after supper.

About 12.15? A.M. we were almost $\frac{1}{2}$ way back to Donnybrook when we saw the U.F.O. It was hovering motionless at about tree top level above a paddock near the road. I stopped the car. It was a very smooth oval disc approx 40 feet in diameter, with small round windows lit from the inside, and a very powerful beam of light - like sunlight coming from the centre of the base to the ground. It was lightish white metallic-looking with no sign of bolts or rivets - just totally smooth. Suddenly the beam of light changed to a Kaleidoscope of beautiful colours, ending with blue. It took off straight upwards and was gone in a flash - so fast we were amazed! I recall being very scared - the hairs on the back of my neck stood up!

We decided not to report the sighting for fear of being ridiculed.

The date was July 25/26 1965.

Annette was a nurse, but later became Matron of St. John of God Hospital Bunbury. I went to Sydney and met my husband there.
